Saturday, June 2, 2001

Class 1 – California Warm Up will not be judged.

Classes 2, 3, 4 SWVHJA Green Hunter – Sponsored by Mountain View Greenhouses & The Jefferson Florist. Open to horses only in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences of any height. Fences to be 2'6" or 3'. (Both heights must be offered). Horses shown in three shows or less at fence heights of less than 2'6" can retain their green status. This will be permitted only once per horse.

Classes 5, 6, 7 SWVHJA Low Hunter – Sponsored by Mr. and Mrs. Fred F. Burks. Open to horses. Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Fences 3'.

Classes 8, 9, 10 SWVHJA Working Hunter – In honor of Nancy Peterson and the Hollins Riding Department and sponsored by Kathleen Nowacki-Correia, Class of 1975. Open to horses. Judged on performance, manners and way of going. Fences 3'3" – 3'6".

Classes 11, 12, 13 SWVHJA Adult Amateur Hunter – Sponsored by Animal Medical Associates, Drs Stan & Kathy Eichelberger. Open to adults mounted on horses and ponies. To be judged on performance, manners and way of going. Ponies shown by an adult may not be shown in the Pony Hunter Division at the same show. Fences to be 3'. Management may combine this division with the Children's Hunter division if there are fewer than three entries.

Class 14 SWVHJA Adult Equitation on the Flat – Sponsored by Catawba Capital Management. Open to amateurs 18 years of age and older. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Judged on position, control, and guidance. AHSA tests 1-18 may be used. Three entries are necessary to fill this class. Riders need not be members of SWVHJA to compete.

Class 15 SWVHJA Adult Medal (25 and under) – Sponsored by Saddles and Stuff.

Class 16 SWVHJA Adult Medal (26 and over) – Sponsored by Sandra Worthy.

Same as for SWVHJA Hunter Seat Medal (Class 17) except that riders must be 18 years of age or older. Ponies may be ridden by adults, but may not be shown in the Pony Hunter division at the same show.

The Rockbridge Hunt, its volunteers, Hollins University, or SWVHJA, Inc. will not be held responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to horse or guest.

Sunday, June 3, 2001 (continued)

Classes 46, 47, 48 SWVHJA Special Children's Hunter – Sponsored by The Bailey family. Open to junior riders mounted on horses or ponies. Judged on performance, manners and way of going. Fences to be 2'6" or 2'9". Horse/rider combination may not compete over fences higher than 2'9" at the same show. Special division may be combined if there are fewer than 3 entries in either section.

Class 49 SWVHJA Jr. Equitation on the Flat (14 & under) – Sponsored by The Bowring family. The Bud Hickman Perpetual Trophy. Open to riders who will not have reached their 18th birthday as of Dec. 1 of the calendar year. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Judged on position, control, and guidance. AHSA tests 1-18 may be used. Three entries are necessary to fill this class. Riders need not be members of SWVHJA to compete.

Classes 50, 51, 52 SWVHJA Small and Medium Pony Hunter - Sponsored by Wyle-A-Way Farm, Mr. & Mrs. Frank Farmer, Jr. Classes 53, 54, 55 SWVHJA Large Pony Hunter – Sponsored by Dr. and Mrs. G. E. Clapsaddle. Open to ponies ridden by juniors. Judged on performance, manners, & way of going. Small ponies jump 2', medium ponies jump 2'3" and large ponies jump 2'9". Divisions must be offered split but if there are not three ponies in either the Small/Medium or Large Pony division, the divisions must be combined. Lines less than 72' must be set on appropriate distances.

Class 56 SWVHJA Pony Medal – Sponsored by The Moskal family. Open to junior member of SWVHJA mounted on ponies. To be shown over a minimum of 6 jumps at the appropriate heights. A minimum of 6 riders, if available, must be called back to work on the flat. Martingales may not be used in the flat phase. Each phase to count 50%. The same pony must be used for both phases. To qualify for the finals, a rider must accumulate 20 points. Four entries are required to fill this class. After rider is qualified, he may not compete in this class. If no Pony Medal is offered, a rider may compete in the Hunter Seat Medal. A rider cannot compete in both Medals in one day, nor can they participate in both finals in one year.

In accordance with Virginia State Law, all exhibitors will be required to sign a liability waiver. Juniors under 18 will need a parent's or legal guardian's signature.

Class 25 4H-Pony Club Equitation – Walk-Trot

Class 26 4H-Pony Club Equitation – Walk-Trot-Canter

Sponsored by Mr. Frank Bierman. The Arlene Conner Future Foxhunter Trophy, sponsored by David Bolen, will be awarded to the High Point Rider from Classes 25 & 26.

Classes 27, 28, 29 BRHF Intermediate Hunter Rider –

Sponsored by Natural Bridge Hospital for Animals. Judged as an equitation class. This class is intended for Intermediate riders. Riders may not show in any other over fences classes at the same show. Rider is an Intermediate for 24 months. If rider moves up within the 24 month period he or she can not return to Intermediate status.

Classes 30, 31, 32 SWVHJA Intermediate Hunter – Sponsored by Laura Arnold and family. Open to anyone in their first or second year of showing who has not shown over fences 2' or higher. Fences 2'3".

Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Rider may not jump higher than 2'9" at the same show.

Classes 33, 34, 35 BRHF Pony Hunter – Sponsored by W. A. (Pete) Whitlock. Fences 2'6".

Classes 36, 37, 38 BRHF Hopeful Hunter – Sponsored by

Totally Digital. Fences 2'3". Horses only to accumulate points toward year-end award.

Class 39 Owners Up Under Saddle – Sponsored by C. Morton. Perpetual Trophy donated by Katharine Sanford Conner.

Class 40 Field Hunter over Fences – Sponsored by Mr. and Mrs. Edwin L. Dooley, Jr. "Warlord" Perpetual Trophy

donated by Joan Alberti. Open to horses and ponies that have hunted at least three times with a recognized hunt.

Class 41 Warm Up (fences 2'6") will not be judged.

Classes 42, 43, 44 SWVHJA Special Adult Hunter – Sponsored by Anita Claytor. Open to Adult Amateur riders mounted on horses or ponies. Judged on performance, manners and way of going. Fences to be

2'6" or 2'9". Horse/rider combination may not compete over fences higher than 2'9" at the same show. Special division may be combined if there are fewer than 3 entries in either section.

Class 45 RMC Medal – \$15 entry fee – Sponsored by

C. Morton. Open to junior and amateur riders showing in Special Children's or Special Adult Hunter Divisions who have not qualified for SWVHJA Pony Medal or Adult Medal finals during the year 2000 or 2001.

Saturday, June 2, 2001 (continued)

Class 17 SWVHJA Hunter Seat Medal – Sponsored by Ann and Alan Layman. Open to riders who have not reached their 18th

birthday as of Dec. 1 of the calendar year. To be shown over a course of fences not to exceed 3' that must include two changes of direction, a combination, and at least three oxers. A minimum of six riders, if available, must be called back to work on the flat. Martingales may not be used in the flat phase. Each phase to count 50%. Same horse must be used for both phases. To qualify for the finals, a rider must accumulate 20 points. Four entries required to fill the class. If there are fewer than four entries, this class may be combined with Adult Medal. No high score will be given. After a rider is qualified for the finals, he or she may not compete in this class. Rider must be a member of SWVHJA.

Classes 18, 19, 20 SWVHJA Children's Hunter – Sponsored by Mr. and Mrs. John Russell. Open to juniors mounted on horses. To

be judged on manners, performance, and way of going. Fences to be 3'. Mgmt. may combine this division with the Adult Hunter division if there are fewer than three entries.

Class 21 SWVHJA Junior Equitation on the Flat (15-17 years of age) – Sponsored by Cornerstone Appraisal Co. of

Botetourt County - Paula L. Ursoy, CRA. Open to riders who will not have reached their 18th birthday as of Dec. 1 of the calendar year. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Judged on position, control, and guidance. AHSA tests 1-18 may be used. Three entries are necessary to fill this class. Riders need not be members of SWVHJA to compete.

Classes 22, 23, 24 Modified Junior-Amateur Hunter –

Sponsored by Joan and Nick Alberti. Open to horses ridden by juniors and amateurs. Fences 3'3".

Directions: Take I-81 to Hollins Exit 146. At the traffic light, turn left onto Route 11 North. At the next traffic light, turn left into Hollins University. Follow the signs for the Riding Center and the Horse Show.
