Hunt Challenge – awarded to the Hunt with the most points of the day

Class Schedule

- 1. Warm up** – Open to all horses and ponies. Performance, manner and way-of-going.
- 2. Senior - Working Hunter over Fences**
- 3. Junior - Working Hunter over Fences.** Junior riders are 18 years of age and under as of December 31, 2004.
- 4. Jr/Sr Equitation Class** - To be divided if entries warrant.
- 5. Green Working Hunter over Fences** – open to horses or ponies in their first or second year of hunting and/or showing
- 6. Field Hunter Class** – Open to horse and rider combinations who are currently members of a recognized hunt and are regularly and fairly hunting.
- 7. Ladies' & Gentleman's Hack** – Walk, trot, canter, and gallop, halt and stand. Class split between Ladies & Gentlemen. Senior riders only. Junior class if entries warrant.
- 8. Handy Hunter** – May be asked to trot a fence, gallop, stand, back, lead horse over fence, open gate, cross natural terrain, or accept a stirrup cup.
- 9. Pairs over Fences** – two riders over a course of jumps, several of which are to be jumped abreast, with a change of order.
- 10. Team over Fences** – three or more riders over a course of jumps, several of which are to be jumped abreast, with a change of order.
- 11. Master's Championship Class** – Open to the 1st and 2nd place horse and rider combination in each class. Qualified riders to follow Field master simulating fox hunting conditions. May be asked to perform additional tasks at the judge's discretion.

Conditions

- Judge: Ann McClung
- Show managers: Terry Whitmore (540-291-1861) and Carol Atwood (540-463-1000)
- Schooling allowed beginning at 10:00 a.m.
- Jumps not to exceed 3 ft and course has 10-12 obstacles that could be seen in the hunt field. All classes are on an outside course.
- Classes will be divided between Juniors and Seniors if entries warrant. Juniors are 18 years of age and under as of December 31, 2004.
- A liability release must be signed by any person riding in a Rockbridge Hunt event and persons under the age of 18 must have the release signed by a parent or guardian!
- Attire is formal hunt and safety hard hat is required. ASTM-approved helmet required for juniors.
- Proof of negative Coggins Test within 12 months required.
- Six ribbons in each class and Champion of the day to be awarded (Class 10).
- All dogs must be on a leash.
- Light concessions available.
- Pre-entry \$10.00 per class, Post Entry \$15.00 per class. Pre-entries must be received by Thursday, December 1st.
- Call Rockbridge Hunt Line (540) 462-1113 for inclement weather decision.

Directions

- From Lexington & further North: I-81 South to I-64 West. Take 1st exit off I-64, Exit 55 to Lexington. Go left on Rt. 11 South. Proceed thru 3 traffic lights. Cross bridge over Maury River, road forks so stay to left onto Rt.11 Bypass. At next light continue straight onto Rt. 251 (Link Rd). Proceed ~ 4 miles. Cross bridge over Buffalo Creek & turn left on Cedar Hill Church Rd (Rt 675). At "T" (no stop sign) turn right onto Broadview driveway. Go past stone house, through barnyard and park in field beyond.
- From Natural Bridge & South of Lexington: I-81 North to Rt. 11 North/Natural Bridge Exit 180. At top of exit ramp turn left onto Rt. 11 North. Travel ~ 7 miles and turn left at the Rt. 11 bypass/Rt 251 intersection (traffic light). Proceed ~ 4 miles. Cross bridge over Buffalo Creek & turn left on Cedar Hill Church Rd (Rt 675). At "T" (no stop sign) turn right onto Broadview driveway. Go past stone house, through barnyard and park in field beyond.
