Requirements:

Helmets or hunt caps are required for all jumping entries and all junior entries.

- Virginia state law requires a current negative coggins test certificate be available for inspection. Please bring a copy to speed up registration.
- All participants must register and sign a waiver of liability. Parent or guardian must sign for entrants under 18 years of age.
- All dogs must be on leash.

Entry fees (includes light refreshments):

\$25 per horse / adult rider combination

\$20 per horse / junior rider (under 18)

Directions: From Interstate 81, take Exit 180 (one of two Natural Bridge exits) and go north on Route 11 (Lee Highway) for about two miles. Turn left on Fox Hunt Road (Route 739). When the road forks, stay to the left on Fox Hunt Road. Take the next possible right turn (Harkto Loop) into the parking lot.

Awards: Ribbons awarded for first to sixth places, with two ribbons per team.

Teams: Teams will consist of two riders. (Three entries may ride together but only two will be eligible for awards. Un-judged riders must also pay entry fee.) **Juniors under the age of twelve must be accompanied by an adult entry on horseback.**

Start times: Teams for all divisions may start any time between 10:30 a.m. and noon. **The last team must start no later than noon.** Please call the hunt line – 540-462-1113. If the weather is unseasonably warm we may start teams at 10:00 a.m.

There will be a five-minute check in the middle of all courses.

Hunter Optimum division: The course will be about 8 miles over rolling terrain with optional jumps. Most of the jumps will be coops, three feet or less in height. The pace should simulate a day of hunting and will average about 7-8 miles per hour.

Hilltopper division: Follows the same course as the Hunter Optimum division with go-arounds at all jumps. The pace will be slightly slower than the Hunter Optimum division.

Trail division: The course will be about 5 miles over rolling terrain with no jumps. The pace will average about 5 miles per hour.

Winning Times for all divisions will be set by members of the Rockbridge Hunt riding the course and will be announced after the results are tabulated.

Light refreshments will be provided.
