Get to Interstate I-64 West of Charlottesville, take Exit 107 (Rt. 250) West, go @ 15 mi. TL onto Rt. 151 S, ...proceed...

From North, South & West of the Blue Ridge Mtns:

Get to junction of Interstate I-81 (Exit 221 South of Staunton) and Interstate I-64 East. Take I-64 East towards Afton/Charlottesville, go @ 9 mi. to Exit 99, Rt. 250 East, go @ 3 mi., at the base of the mountain TR onto Rt. 151 S, ...proceed... @ 8 mi., TL onto Rt. 635 (Greenfield Rd.), just past Ashley's Market, TL onto Rt. 635 (Greenfield Rd.), go @ 1.3 mi. to Tea Time Farm, TL park in the field across the driveway from the turn out shed.

Take Interstate I-64 West to Interstate I-81 South 1 mi., Exit 220 Rt. 262 NW (old Rt. 275), go 4.3 mi.,... all...

From South/West: Take Interstate I-81 North to Exit 220 Rt. 262 NW (old Rt. 275), go 4.3 mi.,... all...

From North/West: Take Interstate I-81 to Exit 225 (North Staunton) Rt. 262 SW (old Rt. 275), go 8 mi.,... all

All proceed... to Rt. 254 West (Parkersburg Turnpike) Exit. Go West (towards Mountains) @50 yds., TL onto Rt. 693 (Cedar Green Rd.). Go 1.2 mi., cross RR bridge, TR onto Rt. 703 (Hebron Rd.), Go .9 mi., TL following Rt. 708 onto Eidson Creek Rd. (actually on Rt.710), Go .5 mi., BEAR RIGHT at fork onto Rt. 708 (Glebe School Rd.), Go .5 mi., BEAR RIGHT at next fork continuing on Rt. 708 (Glebe School Rd.), Go .5 mi., TR onto Rt. 707 (Livick Rd.). Fixture is at the junction of Glebe School Rd. & Livick Rd. Park through gate on Left.

From junction of Interstates I-64 and I-81 (Exit 221)...proceed... @ 32.4 mi. to Exit 180B (1 of 2 Natural

Bridge exits). Take Rt. 11 N (Lee Highway) for about two miles. TL on Fox Hunt Road (Route 739). When the road forks, stay to the left on Fox Hunt Rd., TR at 1st possible turn onto (Hark to Loop) into the parking area.

Warning: Some internet directions will take direct you along roads that either no longer exist or are unsuitable for horse trailers.

From Lexington & further North: I-81 South to I-64 West. Take 1st exit off I-64, Exit 55 to Lexington. Go left on Rt. 11 South. Proceed thru 3 traffic lights. Cross bridge over Maury River, road forks so stay to left onto Rt.11 Bypass. At next light continue straight onto Rt. 251 (Link Rd). Proceed 5 miles. Cross bridge over Buffalo Creek & turn left on Cedar Hill Church Rd (Rt 675) At "T" (no stop sign) turn right onto Zollmans Mill Roads. Go past stone house, through barnyard and park in field beyond.

From North & East of the Blue Ridge Mtns

This may be an option but please check it out first. Take Rt. 6 S to Rt. 151 S or Rt. 29 South to Amherst, continue on Rt. 29 by-pass to Rt.130/Rt. 501, at Big Island, turn onto Rt. 122 South ...proceed...

From the intersection of Interstates I-64 and I-81 (Exit 221), go @ 32.4 mi. to Exit 180B (one of two Natural Bridge exits). TL onto Route 11 South, go @ 3.9 mi. to Route 130 East, go @12.6 mi., BEAR Right continuing on Route 130 which is also Route 501, when you get back to the James River, at the foot of the mtn., TR to stay on Route 501 South. Go 4.5 mi., at Big Island, TR onto Route 122 South,...proceed...

to go 11.2 mi., TL onto Route 643 (Otterville Rd.), go @ 1.5 mi. crossing Otter River Bridge, go up slight hill and look for BCH sign. TL onto Iroquois Trail, go down gravel rd. @0.5 mi. and park in hay field on right.
