Foxhunting Clinic

This is a mounted clinic. Anyone with an interest in foxhunting is welcome! We'll split into groups appropriate for a variety of riders and horses.

We have clinicians with a lot of experience in training both horses and riders. **Diane Long** has more than 30 years of experience training horses for show, pleasure, racing, and hunting. She has introduced many horses and riders to riding cross-country and hunting. **Alex Bobbitt** of Stony Lonesome Farm is an established trainer who has helped a variety of riders including grand prix jumper riders, FEI dressage, professional eventers as well as veterinarians and judges. He uses techniques drawn from all areas of horsemanship focuses on instilling willingness and trust in horses. Additional clinicians are available if necessary.

You may ride in a session with either Diane or Alex or a session with each. We'll finish the day with a mock hunt or trail ride. For each session, we'll divide the group based on each horse and rider's level of preparedness.

We are asking for pre-registration. We must know how many people plan to attend. And this is your chance to tell us about specific problems you'd like to address. Directions to Broadview Ranch from Lexington VA.

Warning! Some internet directions will take direct you along roads that either no longer exist or are unsuitable for horse trailers.

1. I-81 South to Exit 190 for Route 60.
2. Take Route 60 West toward Lexington.
3. As you enter Lexington, go through first stop light, get in the left lane and turn left onto the Route 11 By-pass just before the second stop light.
4. Go about 1 mile to the stoplight - go straight through. You will now be on Route 251. Proceed about 5 miles.
5. Cross bridge over Buffalo Creek & turn left on Cedar Hill Church Road (Route 675). Go 1 mile.
6. At "T" (no stop sign) turn right onto Zollmans Mill Road. You should see the mailbox for Broadview Ranch. Follow signs for parking.
