

Rockbridge Hunt hosts 3 Hunt Weekend

on Sunday, October 10, 2010

Directions to the fixture: Windward Farm.

It takes about fifteen minutes to drive to the fixture from the interstate.

From Interstate 81, take Exit 180 (one of two Natural Bridge exits) and go north on Route 11 (Lee Highway) for about 1.3 miles. Turn right onto Falling Springs Road (Route 680). After about 1.5 miles the road forks -- stay to the right on Lone Jack Road. After about a half mile, you'll come to a stop sign. Turn right on Forge Road (Route 608). Go about a half mile and turn right on Poague Lane. There will be signs or ribbons. You'll follow this lane, crossing two creeks. You'll turn left in front of the barn and park in the field.

Nearby accommodations include:

Budget Inn is at the exit mentioned above. It's less than five miles from the fixture and adjacent to the Pink Cadillac Diner. And it's almost directly across the road from Stone Bridge Farm.

Natural Bridge Hotel is about 5 miles from Stone Bridge Farm. And it's another 5 or 6 miles to the fixture.

Both of those are about one hour from either Bedford County Hunt or Glenmore Hunt.

The only practical **stabling** option is <u>Stone Bridge Farm</u>. It's less than a mile from the exit when you leave the interstate. They have plenty of stalls and frequently handle "overnights."

In case of inclement weather, we will probably change the fixture to Hunt, Inc. This fixture is slightly closer to both Stone Bridge Farm and the interstate.

Directions to the alternate fixture: Hunt, Inc.

From Interstate 81, take Exit 180 (one of two Natural Bridge exits) and go north on Route 11 (Lee Highway) for about two miles. Turn left on Fox Hunt Road (Route 739). When the road forks, stay to the left on Fox Hunt Road. Take the next possible right turn (Harkto Loop) into the parking lot.
