## Foxhunting is alive and well in Rockbridge County!

We've set aside Saturday, September 26 to entertain our cowboy friends with a sample of traditional mounted foxhunting.

If you and your horse have experience with trail riding in a group then you're ready to try foxhunting! We generally hunt for 2 to 3 hours. There will be a group that may go fast, if the hounds find a fox or coyote, and there's a group that will go slower. If you need to come in early, someone will make sure you get back to the parking area.

After hunting we'll share a "tailgate" meal – everyone brings some food to share. If you want to spend the night, camping and stabling can be arranged at Broadview Ranch. Contact Carol Atwood, 540-463-1000.

Cost? Every rider who is not a member of Rockbridge Hunt must pay a capping fee -- but we've reduced that for this particular day to twenty-five dollars. (The capping fee is usually fifty dollars.)

In addition, after hunting on Saturday, if you paid the capping fee on Saturday and ride in the Poker Ride on Sunday, September 27, you'll get a ten dollar discount on the entry fee! This is a marked trail ride of 6 to 8 miles with different divisions – some are timed and some are not. And lunch is included!

Now for those evil details. It's nothing unusual.

- Every rider will have to wear some kind of protective headgear.
- Every rider needs safe riding boots of some kind – no tennis shoes!
- Other than that, casual attire is fine – chaps, jeans, polo shirts – but remember we'll be riding through the woods part of the time.
- Every rider must sign a waiver.
- Every horse must have a negative Coggins test.

## Directions to Broadview Ranch

**Warning: Some internet directions will take direct you along roads that either no longer exist or are unsuitable for horse trailers.**

### **From Lexington & further North:**

Interstate 81 South to Interstate 64 West.

Take 1st exit off I-64, Exit 55 to Lexington.

Go left on Route 11 South. Proceed thru 3 traffic lights.

Cross bridge over Maury River, road forks so stay to left onto Rt.11 Bypass.

At next light continue straight onto Rt. 251 (Link Rd). Proceed about 5 miles.

Cross bridge over Buffalo Creek & turn left on Cedar Hill Church Rd (Rt 675). Go 1 mile.

At "T" (no stop sign) turn right onto Zollmans Mill Road.

Go 1/10th mile, road ends at Broadview Ranch. Follow signs for parking.

### **From Natural Bridge & South of Lexington:**

Take Interstate 81 North to Exit 180 - Route 11 North at Natural Bridge.

At top of exit ramp turn left onto Route 11 North. Travel about 7 miles.

Turn left at the Route 11 bypass/Rt 251 intersection (traffic light).

Proceed about 5 miles.

Cross bridge over Buffalo Creek & immediately turn left on Cedar Hill Church Road (Route 675). Go 1 mile.

At "T" (no stop sign) turn right onto Zollmans Mill Road.

Go 1/10th mile road ends at Broadview Ranch.

Follow signs for parking.
