- **1. Important Reminders: Insurance, waivers, and helmets!** The new year has started for us so that means *new waivers are needed for everyone*. For insurance purposes, it is *critical* that any member or guest riding at The Hunt, Inc. have a signed waiver on file. There is a box with new 2020-21 waivers on the mounting block in The Hunt, Inc. parking lot and another on the hunt barn. You can leave your signed waiver in the box and I will pick them up. We also *strongly encourage* everyone to wear approved helmets when riding.

2. More Reminders - Summer Trail Riding at The Hunt, Inc. Rockbridge Hunt members have permission from many generous landowners to *hunt* on their property. This does not entitle any individuals to *trail ride* on private property. Rockbridge Hunt members can ride on much of the property at The Hunt, Inc. but you must know where the boundaries are and respect them. Many of our landowners do allow trail riding but not all of them do. When individuals ride on private property without permission, landowners are (justifiably) displeased. These situations are one of the main causes of permission to hunt being withdrawn. If you don't absolutely know for certain where you can ride and where you can't, please make arrangements to ride with someone who knows the territory. Most of the Executive Committee and the Hunt Staff know the property and will be happy to meet you and ride with you.

Also, please be very certain that any dogs you have with you are under your control at *all times* and kept off private property.

3. Judged Trail Ride. As Virginia begins to open up again, we are ready to restart our "fundraising season." Our first organized event will be our Judged Trail Ride at Broadview on Saturday, July 25. It will be part of a series with similar events at Glenmore, Oak Ridge, and Bedford County hunts. Liz Hall and the Broadview team have started to pull that event together for us. Mark your calendar and watch for more details about how you can volunteer or enter the event to support your Hunt.

Holloa - Pronounced "holler." A scream to denote that a fox has been sighted. (Variations - View Holloa, Halloo or View halloo)

Excerpt from "The Hounds of Heaven" by Willy Poole

"The fox slipped through the fence at the end of the field. Fred rose in his stirrups and **holloaed**. A good 'view **holloa**' cannot be reduced to print; it is a spine-tingling, nerve-jangling screech – a long descanting scream, as old as hunting itself, that tells everybody that the quarry has 'gone away'."

Excerpt from "Sketch of a Fox Chase" in American Turf Register and Sporting Magazine "Now let your huntsman throw in his hounds as quietly as he can, and let the two whippers-in keep wide of him on either hand, so that a single hound may not escape them; let them be attentive to his halloo, and be ready to encourage or rate, as that directs; he will, of course, draw up the wind, for reasons which I shall give in another place. Now if you can keep your brother sportsmen in order, and put any discretion into them, you are in luck; they more frequently do harm than good: if it be possible, persuade those who wish to halloo the fox off to stand quiet under the cover side, and on no account to halloo him too soon; if they do, he most certainly will turn back again."
