- **2.** Volunteers' Hunt. This year's Volunteers' Hunt to reward members who come out to help clear trails and maintain our hunt country will be Saturday, September 7 at The Hunt, Inc. at 8:00 AM.
- **3. Kick-off Party.** The Executive Committee is busy making plans for our annual party to kick off the hunting season on **Saturday, September 7**, at the Tex Tilson Lodge. At 4:00 PM you can get a look inside the Kennels with Huntsman Jake Wilson, MFH and see our foxhounds and last year's pups that are getting ready to hunt for the first time this fall! The rest of the evening's events will start at 5:00 PM at the Tex Tilson Lodge. Reservations are not needed for this casual event.

One of the features of this annual gathering is a silent auction to help raise funds for our award-winning hounds. If you have something you would be willing to donate for the silent auction, please let Hugh Brown know. If you or someone you know would be willing to donate a service (riding lessons, animal care, etc) that would be great!

This is a potluck affair – the main course and beverages will be provided. Please bring an appetizer, side dish, or dessert to share. Please let Hugh know if there is someone you would like to receive an invitation. We hope to see you there!

4. Hound Sponsorship. We traditionally focus a lot of our Kick-Off Party energy on our hound sponsorship program. We are hopeful that many of our Rockbridge Hunt members and friends will consider choosing and sponsoring a hunting hound this year. We extend a big "Thank you!" to those of you who have already reached out to sponsor your hound again or to sponsor for the first time. Throughout the year our hounds must be fed, vaccinated, given flea preventative treatments and receive medical attention. We can expect to spend over \$330 on each hound each year. The importance of hound sponsorship cannot be overstated. Your contributions are vital to the well-being of our pack. Sponsorship for an entire year is \$250, or \$125 for a half year. 5. Are you licensed to Hunt? Remember to get a new Virginia Hunting License before the start of hunting season. This is *not optional*; everyone must purchase and carry a current hunting license. We recommend that you get a statewide license if you plan to attend joint meets away from home. You can purchase licenses several ways:

In person at local license agents located around the Commonwealth. Licenses are also sold by some clerks of the Circuit Court.

- **6. Getting Ready for the Hunt Season.** The start of hunting season is only a few weeks away now! Our huntsman and staff are hard at work training the hounds for the upcoming season. Here are some things you can be doing now to get ready for the fall:
 - 1. Buy a Hunting License. This is *not optional*, everyone must purchase and carry a current hunting license. (See "Are you Licensed to Hunt" above for instructions.)
 - 2. Start legging up your horse and yourself!
 - 3. Make sure your Coggins is up to date, along with other vaccinations and worming.
 - 4. Sign a waiver for the season.
 - 5. Pay some or all of your dues.
 - 6. Check your tack for wear and tear.
 - 7. Check your trailer and towing vehicle tire pressure and wear, electrical systems, etc.
